TERN

The rotating, level access shower tray safeguarding independent showering and person centred care.

- Promotes **single carer handling** for effective cleansing.
- **Spend to save solution.**
- **Care Act compliant.**
- **Space saving** - requires no turning circle within the bathroom.
- Soft start/stop electronic operation using a wireless remote.
- Built-in safety time out.
- Can be used as a standard shower tray.
- Anti-slip surface.
- Maintenance free.
- Dry the user with minimum effort by adding a Body Dryer, see opposite.
- Use with half height carer doors, a glass screen or a cubicle.



FLUTED GRABRAILS

- Offers a reassuring grip.
- Variety of styles and sizes available.
- Use to assist pivot transfer into a shower chair.
- Available in white and blue to assist the visually impaired.



REDRING ELECTRIC SHOWER

- Fully thermostatic.
- Pre-programmed to provide hot water at a safe temperature.
- One touch, Start/Stop button.
- Large LED temperature display.



BODY DRYER

- Easily dries the user with minimum effort and without towels.
- Warm pressurised air eliminates any rubbing or chaffing.
- Push button or remote operation.
- Keeps the shower area dry reducing the risk of slipping.
- Wash / dry method when used with a shower tray puts the user in complete control of their shower routine.

HOME CARE vs TERN.

It is an increasingly popular option for people to receive care in the home from a specialist care provider .
A Tern rotating shower tray promotes independence allowing a person to shower without carer assistance, therefore the up front cost of the Tern is significantly less than the ongoing cost of providing home care.

EXAMPLE

Average UK hourly cost of domiciliary care per hour

£13

Average number of hours care provided per week

Care cost per week

£156

Care cost per annum

£8112

RRP TERN TRAY

£1500

The average cost of home care equates to **£8,112** per annum. In contrast, a Tern rotating shower tray will have paid for itself within **8 - 10 weeks** with no ongoing costs, a saving of up to **£6,612**.
